She was born in 1947 in Sárszentmiklós. After graduating from Marx Károly University of Economic Sciences, she taught company economics and reserve economics at this University for seven years. Her career in public administration began at the National Office for Price Control and Material Flows where she dealt with reserve economics. She was then involved in the preparation of the competition regulation from the mid '80s.

From 1991 she was the head of the Competition Policy Section, and then from 1997 to 2009 she was the vice-president of the GVH. From 2011 to 2014, she was a member of the Directorate of the Budapest Metropolitan Management Holding, before becoming its president. Presently she is both a member and the president of the advisory board of the Alternative Economics High School Foundation, a member of the board of supervisors of the Hungarian Civil Liberties Union, vice-president of the Alumni Group of Szent István Economic High School and president of the board of supervisors of the Hungarian Trademark Association.
