Since 1990 works in Federal Antimonopoly Authority (economic council, Head of Division, Head of Department, Stats secretary - Deputy Chairman of State Antimonopoly Committee of the Russian Federation)

1998 - 2004 - Deputy Minister of the Russian Federation for Antimonopoly Policy and Support to Entrepreneurship

2004, July 21 - was appointed by Decree of the Government of the Russian Federation No 977-p as a Deputy Head of Federal Antimonopoly Service

Coordinates issues of competition development and control over antimonopoly legislation in industry, building, chemical, timber and agricultural complex, international cooperation.
