Type of case:	Restrictive agreement
Undertaking(s) concerned:	 Alcufer Ipari Kereskedelmi és Szolgáltató Kft. Fe-Group Invest Vagyonkezelő, Tanácsadó és Nagykereskedelmi Zrt. Jász-Plasztik Kft.
Short description:	The parties are waste management undertakings which had discussions about the sharing of the market of collection of leadacid batteries and the restriction of competition on the market of collection and sale of lead-acid batteries in Hungary.
Decision:	 Alcufer, Fe-Group and Jász-Plasztik committed a single, continuous and complex infringement when they carried out discussions from 26 June 2013 until 27 March 2014 relating to the allocation of the collection market for lead-acid batteries in Hungary, the joint establishment of a price system in which Jász-Plasztik would have offered Alcufer and Fe-Group a favourable purchase price, while it would have offered a price that was detrimental to not party to the agreement, the exchange of confidential and individualized quantity, pricing and shipping data in order to comply with the consortium agreement. The GVH imposed a total fine of HUF 112,520,000 (approx. EUR 360,000) on the undertakings for the infringement.
