Dr. **János Bóka**, completed his law studies in Szeged and Brussels, earning a PhD in 2013. From 2004 to 2009, he worked in the European Parliament.

He taught at the University of Szeged, the National University of Public Service, and Károli Gáspár University of the Reformed Church.

Between 2014 and 2015, he served as senior advisor at the Civil Law Division of the Supreme Court, and later from 2017 to 2018, he was the director of the Hungarian Judicial Academy of the National Office for the Judiciary.

From 2018 to 2021, he was the Secretary of State responsible for European Union and international judicial cooperation at the Ministry of Justice, and from 2022 to 2023, he was the Secretary of State for European Union affairs in the Prime Minister's Cabinet Office. Since 2022, he has been the Prime Minister's Commissioner and EU Sherpa.

As of August 1, 2023, he serves as Hungary's Minister for European Union Affairs.
